



Musings on what we mean by uncrossable using some examples from Day 1 of JK 2023 at Lancaster University.

	Whether you approached from the north or the west the only valid routes to and from 140 involved the steps Running through the dark green to/from the control is not allowed
	The only valid routes to 174 are using the paths from the north or the west that lie "inside" the wall Approaching the control from the south or east of the wall is not allowed Running along the top of the wall (which is over 3m in height) is not allowed (yes it did happen) Crossing the pond or entering the olive green surrounding the pond is not allowed





Taping is definitely not an ideal solution at any sprint or urban event as it requires additional effort and could result in competitors thinking that "this bit isn't taped I must be OK to cross it".
